Coming up: Cellist Matt Haimovitz

**Friday, February 3 at 8pm
Sanders Theatre**

At age 13, when most kids were playing on the Little League team or the school talent show, cellist **Matt Haimovitz** was playing Carnegie Hall. At 18, he released the first of six acclaimed albums with the Deutsche Grammophon label and at 28, became the first cellist to receive the Premio Internazionale "Accademia Musicale Chigiana."

Now a seasoned performer, Haimovitz continues to push the envelope in the music world. His recent **Bach Listening-Room Tour** took Bach's cello suites out of the concert hall and into intimate venues like rock clubs, pizza parlors and coffeehouses.

Haimovitz's newest album, *Goulash*, released by his own record label (www.oxingale.com) debuted in September at #23 on the Billboard Classical Chart.
